Dear KoMet Parents:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of a situation that the school district became aware of last evening and to reassure you that students are safe to attend school today.

At about 8:30 PM following the KMHS band concert, HS principal Mr. Langemo was made aware of an allegation of concerning statements made by a high school student during the late afternoon. Mr. Langemo immediately began an investigation and involved School Resource Officer Jesse Kasel, who coordinated a response and investigation with the Kasson Police Department. The student who is alleged to have made the statements will not be in school today and we have been informed by law enforcement that the school day should continue as normal and that all students are safe.

We are grateful that students came forward to school administration with their concerns so that we could take necessary and appropriate steps to ensure safety for our students. We are also thankful for our partnership and communication with local law enforcement as we work together to keep our students safe.
